

**Guidelines For Exhibiting Framed Photos  
Green Valley Recreation Camera Club  
2015-2016**



GVR Camera Club members are encouraged to display their personal printed photographic pictures at locations arranged for by the Exhibit Committee. These venues include the Camera Club, Green Valley Recreation Centers, assisted living facilities in Green Valley, and various local businesses. The exhibit committee **guidelines** for exhibiting photographs in the Camera Club and at outside exhibits are listed below.

- Photographs between a minimum size of 8.5 x 11 inches to a maximum size of 16 x 20 inches including the frame will be accepted.
- Framed photographs should use metal frames with black, silver or pewter colors.
- Frames may use Plexiglas or have no Plexiglas, it's the photographer's choice. No glass is allowed.
- No scratched Plexiglas or scratched frames will be exhibited at outside exhibits.
- Each framed photograph must be wired for hanging. Please note that the wire when extended should not extend above the top of the frame. (See attached photo)
- Photographs may not contain lewd images suggestive titles or discriminatory themes or subjects.

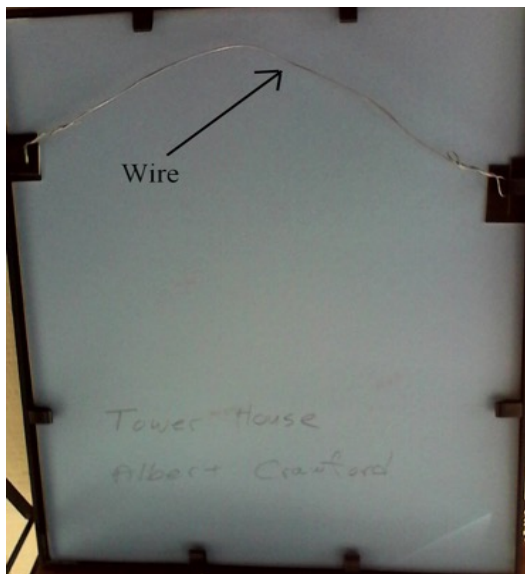
The Club is now also accepting foam-core mounted prints for exhibition.

- Foam-core prints should be between a minimum of 8 x 10 and a maximum of 16 x 20 outside dimensions.
- The photo should be attached to the foam-core board with contact cement or spray adhesive.
- Because of the light weight of foam-core mounted prints, a ribbon may be attached to the back of the mount with hot glue in place of a wire. (See attached photo)

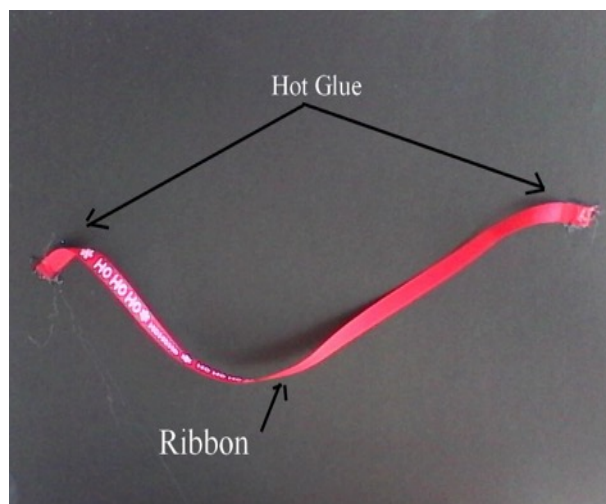
Any photographs submitted should have the following information on the back:

1. Your name
2. Your email address
3. A short title for your picture
4. Your phone number

When your picture is ready for exhibit, give it to the monitor on duty at the Club room in Santa Rita Springs. The Exhibit Committee will take it from there. The Exhibit Committee is responsible for hanging the pictures and the maintenance of the exhibit boards.
